The **National Inclusion Project** opens doors for all young people to be included together and experience all that life has to offer. We conduct programs with community partners to teach others how to be inclusive so that children with and without disabilities can experience lifelong benefits. By driving the movement for social inclusion in out-of-school and community programs, children of all abilities learn, play and laugh together. To date, the Project has partnered with over 100 programs in 35 states, impacting 25,000 children annually.

What We Do

Our **Let's ALL Play (LAP)** program model brings an inclusive recreational experience to children with disabilities. Through training, consulting, and scholarships, Let's ALL Play partners give children with disabilities the same experience as those without. ALL children come together to participate in recreational activities such as swimming, arts and crafts, community service, physical fitness and more.

Let's ALL Play trainings, webinars and Power of Play Inclusion Conference are available for any program looking to become inclusive or enhance their current program.

Donate! A donation to the National Inclusion Project provides maximum impact in communities as they move to being fully inclusive. \$25 allows a child with disability to go swimming with their peers for the first time. \$100 provides a field trip for children to experience their community together. \$250 enables us to work with a recreational program to provide a week of camp for a child. \$1000 allows us to give a scholarship to a child with a disability to attend an inclusive camp of their choice. \$1800 provides Let's ALL Play curriculum, training, and supplies to an inclusive program.
